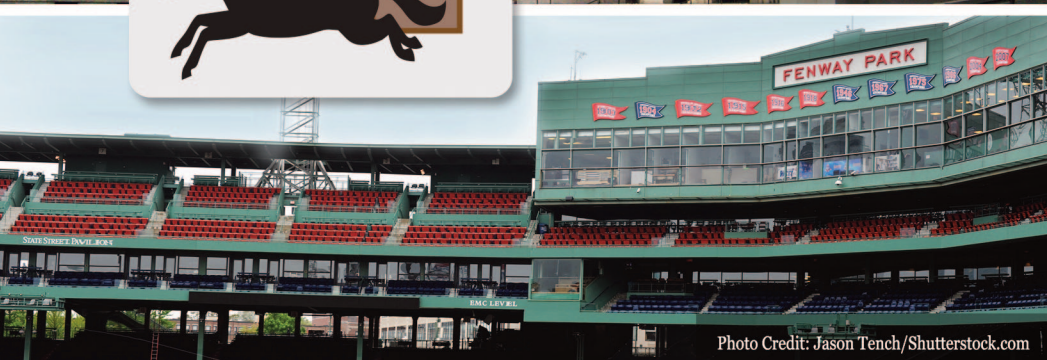
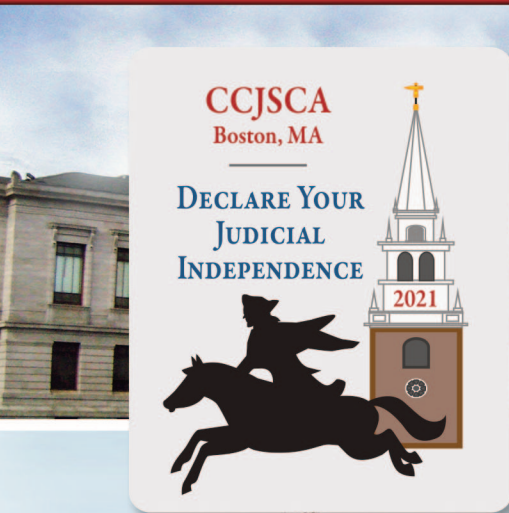

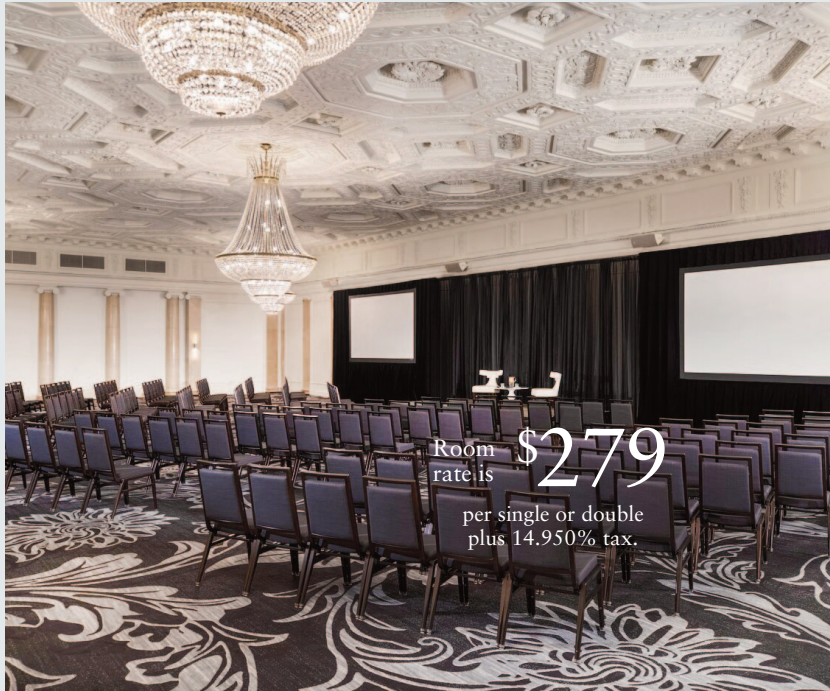
**Farewell Dinner at the Fairmont Copley Plaza**

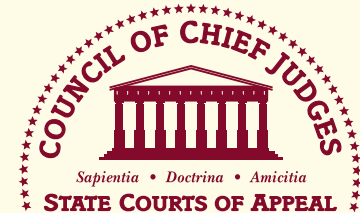
